Making our supply chain more sustainable

To ensure a reliable and sustainable **supply chain**, we initiated a global risk assessment program for our supply chain. This program is designed to identify sustainability issues, before they become problems.

For this approach we are joining forces with Ariba, IntegrityNext, Avetta and other partners.

IntegrityNext and Avetta are global program providers that have extensive experience in monitoring the safety, qualification and social responsibility of companies.

They help **monitoring, informing and assisting** suppliers in complying with the principles of our Supplier Code of Conduct and additional sustainability requirements.

This support allows us to reliably assess and evaluate our suppliers with respect to our **sustainable supply chain standards**.



- We ensure fair, responsible and safe purchasing procedures and collaboration.
- In case of a non-compliant supplier, we strive to implement our sustainability standards in cooperation.
- Only, if all remedy efforts fail, the contractual relationship will have to be terminated.
